# Port Askaig 10 Year Old - 10th Anniversary

This expression of Port Askaig was bottled in celebration of the 10th anniversary of the Port Askaig series, and rather fittingly, it's also 10 years old! The whisky was sourced from an unidentified Islay distillery, based near the village of Port Askaig from which the brand obviously takes its name.

The liquid was drawn from 15% solera sherry butts, 25% first-fill bourbon barrels and 60% refill American oak hogsheads.

Just 10,000 bottles have been produced for sale in select global markets

## Tasting notes

Nose: Aromas of fresh American pancakes with maple syrup and streaky bacon, charred notes of used matchsticks and a floral hint.

Palate: Rye bread and salted butter, maritime samphire, olive oil and sweeter notes of butternut squash and zingy apples, with a backbone of peat smoke.

Finish: Charred orchard fruits, baking spices and a touch of liquorice

## 2002/2018 Taste Notes

### Nose:

The colour is tawny (using caramel to fix it) and the nose offers what I expected and hoped for: An adorable mix of maritime-peaty, PX sherry and sweet malty aromas in a perfect balanced setting.

### Taste:

The taste is delicious sherry and barley sugary sweet that is perfectly countered by the rather bitter phenols and delicious spicy woods, dates, cherries, raisins and salted caramel.

### Finish:

The initial mouthfeel is creamy and instantly coats all of the mouth - ooh, how I like such an arrival! No distracting bitter or drying moments at all, again a perfect cask selection.

Released at Fèis Ìle and around the world, the single malt brings together the best of both Islay and the Caribbean, as it was matured in bourbon casks and then treated to a finish in casks that previously held rum. The final result is a delicious, smoky and fruity party, truly capturing the carnival spirit.

# Ardbeg Drum Limited Edition

## Taste Notes

### Nose:

Bonfire wood smoke intertwines with earthy pine, as sweeter tropical aromas of ripe banana, banana bread and pineapple come to the fore. Some richer notes of dark chocolate and candied ginger add depth.

### Palete:

Loads of spices, with pepper, clove, cinnamon and more ginger surrounded by swirls of earthy smoke, with sweeter notes of liquorice, even more dark chocolate and vanilla pod.

### Finish:

Roasted, slightly burnt coffee beans, and sweet cinnamon and cocoa.

# Port Charlotte Heavily Peated

Peated Bruichladdich single malt released under the Port Charlotte name, produced exclusively with Scottish barley. 50% of the whisky was matured in first-fill American whiskey casks, while the remaining 50% was matured in second-fill French wine casks. These two whiskies were combined and allowed an extra year of maturation in Bordeaux left bank wine casks.

# Port Charlotte Heavily Peated Taste Notes

## Nose:

Ripe blueberry and raspberry, before wafts of smoked barley and bacon arrive.

## Palate:

Sea salt, buttered pancakes, cooked orchard fruits and a drizzle of golden syrup.

## Finish:

Lingering buttery deliciousness, with cedar spices and black pepper.

# Octomore 10 Year Old

The third release of 10 year old Octomore single malt from Bruichladdich - what a treat! This heavily peated expression was drawn from a variety of casks, and the Bruichladdich folks on the Isle of Islay are more than happy to divulge into the details. 37% of the whisky was fully aged in first-fill Port pipes, 31% in first-fill Cognac casks and 20% in second-fill American whiskey casks. The remaining 12% was initially aged in American whiskey casks, then in virgin oak casks, and then back in to more American whiskey casks. The spirit itself was malted to 167 PPM, so expect a familiar helping of powerful smoke. 12,000 bottles were produced.

# Octomore 10 Year Old Taste Notes

Nose: Campfire embers and Custard Cream biscuits, with a hint of black tea underneath. Hints of candied peels and fruity boiled sweeties.

Palate: Toasted oak, roasted apricots, sultana, dry smoke, black pepper, new leather and walnut.

Finish: Lasting cigar box richness and a touch of red chilli chocolate

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
